<p><b>Issue 1</b></p> <p><b>To Reduce Penalties for Crimes of Obtaining, Possessing, and Using Illegal Drugs</b></p> <p><b>Proposed Constitutional Amendment</b></p> <p><b>Proposed by Initiative Petition</b></p> <p><b>To add a new Section 12 to Article XV of the Constitution of the State of Ohio</b></p> <p><b>A majority yes vote is necessary for the amendment to pass.</b></p> <p>If adopted, the amendment would:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Require sentence reductions of incarcerated individuals, except individuals incarcerated for murder, rape, or child molestation, by up to 25% if the individual participates in rehabilitative, work, or educational programming.</li> <li>• Mandate that criminal offenses of obtaining, possessing, or using any drug such as fentanyl, heroin, methamphetamine, cocaine, LSD, and other controlled substances cannot be classified as a felony, but only a misdemeanor.</li> <li>• Prohibit jail time as a sentence for obtaining, possessing, or using such drugs until an individual's third offense within 24 months.</li> <li>• Allow an individual convicted of obtaining, possessing, or using any such drug prior to the effective date of the amendment to ask a court to reduce the conviction to a misdemeanor, regardless of whether the individual has completed the sentence.</li> <li>• Require any available funding, based on projected savings, to be applied to state-administered rehabilitation programs and crime victim funds.</li> <li>• Require a graduated series of responses, such as community service, drug treatment, or jail time, for minor, non-criminal probation violations.</li> </ul> <p><b>SHALL THE AMENDMENT BE APPROVED?</b></p> <p><input type="radio"/> YES</p> <p><input type="radio"/> NO</p>	<p><b>2 Proposed Tax Levy (Renewal) Ashtabula County</b></p> <p><b>A majority affirmative vote is necessary for passage</b></p> <p>A renewal of a tax for the benefit of Ashtabula County for the purpose of current operating expenses of the Ashtabula County Board of Developmental Disabilities at a rate not exceeding 0.5 mill for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to \$0.05 for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for 7 years, commencing in 2018, first due in calendar year 2019.</p> <p><input type="radio"/> For the Tax Levy</p> <p><input type="radio"/> Against the Tax Levy</p>	<p><b>9 Proposed Tax Levy (Replacement) South Central Ambulance District</b></p> <p><b>A majority affirmative vote is necessary for passage</b></p> <p>A replacement of a tax for the benefit of South Central Ambulance District for the purpose of providing ambulance service, emergency medical service, or both at a rate not exceeding 1 mill for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to \$0.10 for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for 5 years, commencing in 2019, first due in calendar year 2020.</p> <p><input type="radio"/> For the Tax Levy</p> <p><input type="radio"/> Against the Tax Levy</p>
